
Whether you are young or old, single or with a family - income protection can give you the financial support you and your family need so that you can concentrate on your recovery, however long that may be.


Our claims in 2019

- The total amount of benefits paid to members was **£5 million**
- The average age of claimants was **47**
- The total number of claims was **1,204**
- The largest claim paid was **£78,060**
- The average payment per claim was **£4,208**

Examples of claims paid to individual members in 2019

Nearly 20 years ago, a member in their 30s began suffering from a tremor which left them unable to practice dentistry and virtually overnight, their yearly income fell from £60,000 to almost nothing. Our income protection plan has been a vital source of financial support since. No one expects such a career ending event to happen to them but an income protection insurance plan can give you long term financial security when you need it most.

A dentist in their late 20s injured their back performing a difficult procedure. Our income protection plan gave them the financial room they needed, for the month it took them to recover fully and return to work.

A member in their 40s began suffering from carpal tunnel syndrome and they were unable to work for over two months. Our income protection plan supported them throughout the time they needed to recover and return to work.

A dentist in their 30s suffered from a neurological condition that affected their sight. For nearly ten years, our income protection plan has been helping replace their annual income loss of nearly £50,000 as a result of this illness.

A member in their 30s was involved in a traffic accident which forced them to take three months off work. As a self employed practitioner, they were grateful for the financial support from our income protection plan during the time they needed to recuperate.

In 2019, we paid 97.2% of new claims.
